Clear cache in Internet Explorer

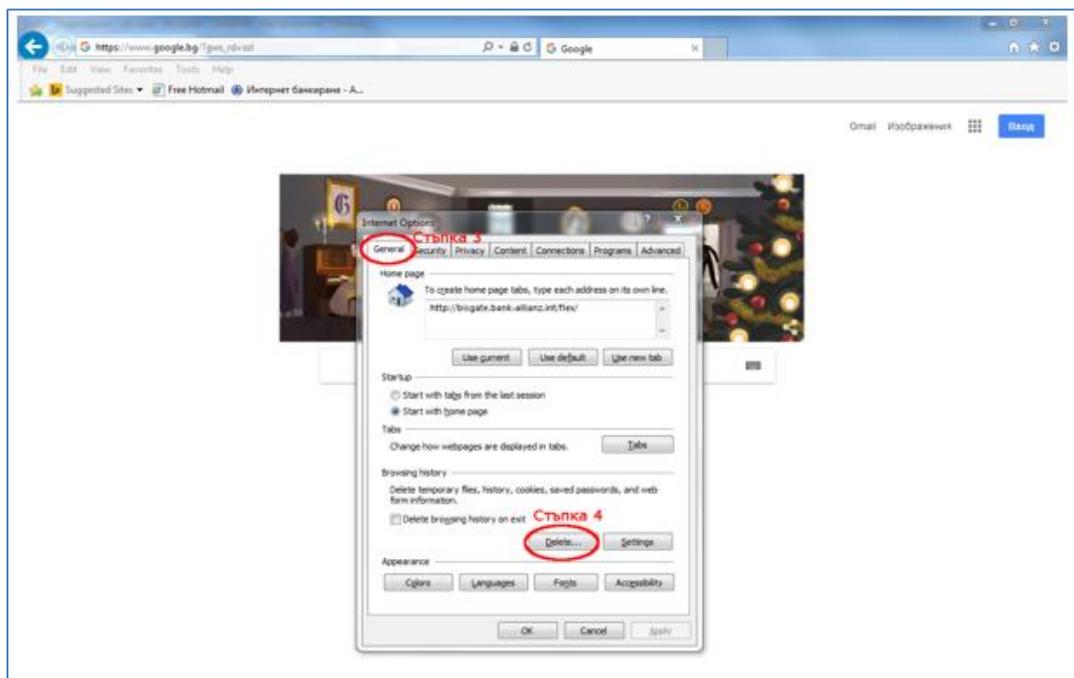
1. In Internet Explorer, click a button Tools menu. The button should be located at the top right, as shown in the picture (Step 1).



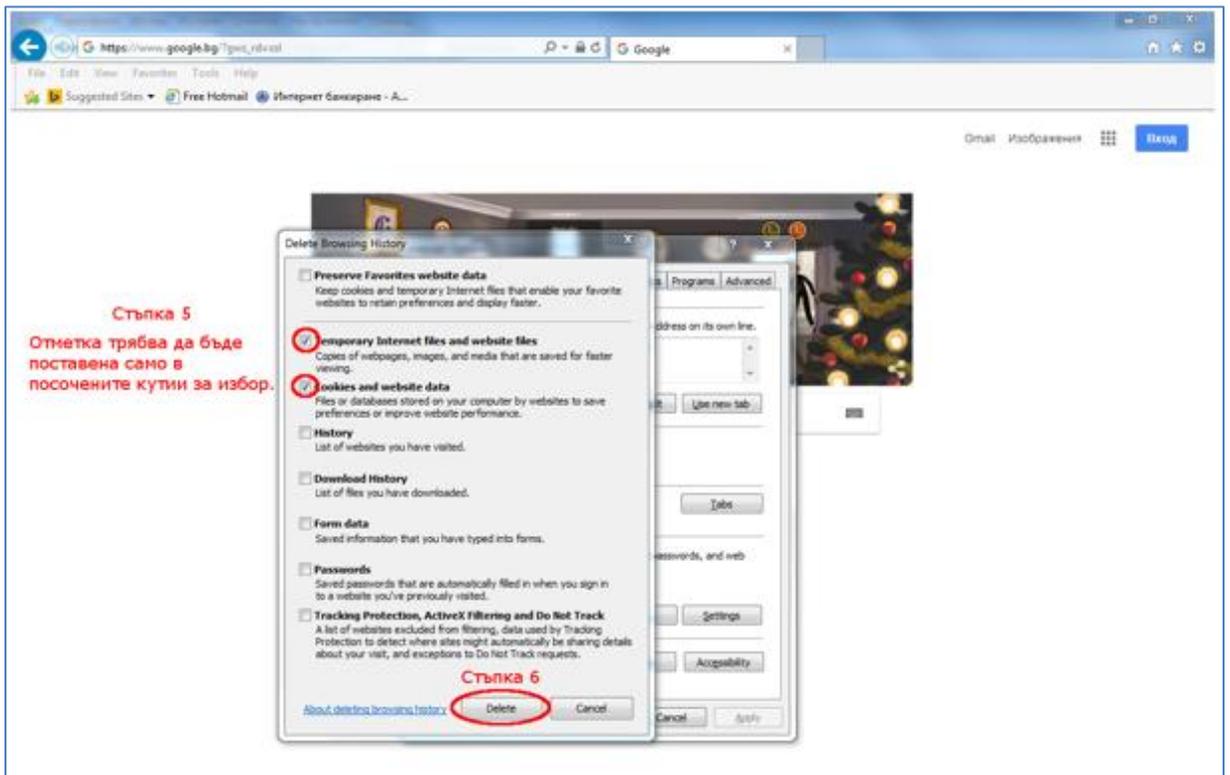
2. From the drop-down menu, select "Internet Options" as shown in the picture (Step 2):



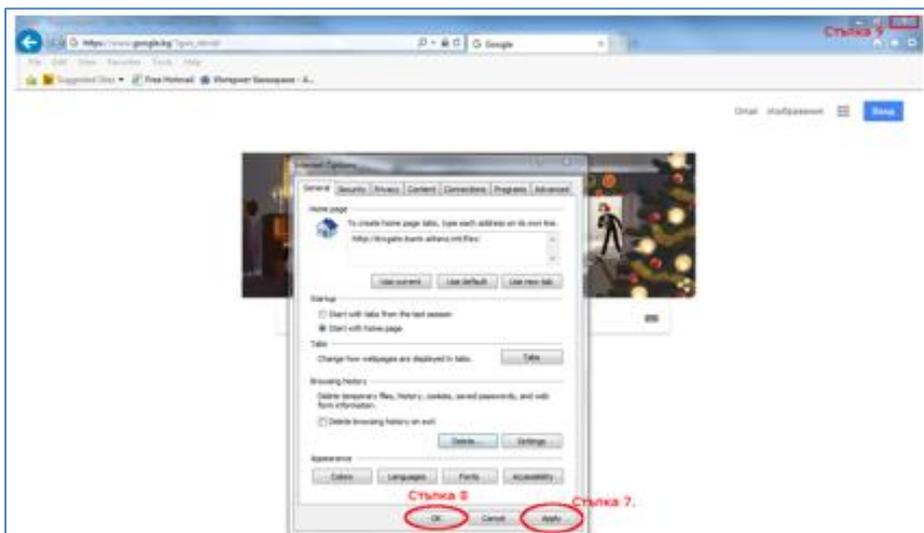
3. Select the "General" tab, which should be selected by default (Step 3). Find the "Delete" button and click on it (Step 4).



4. Check Temporary Internet files and website files and Cookies and website data (Step 5). Then click the "Delete" button (Step 6).

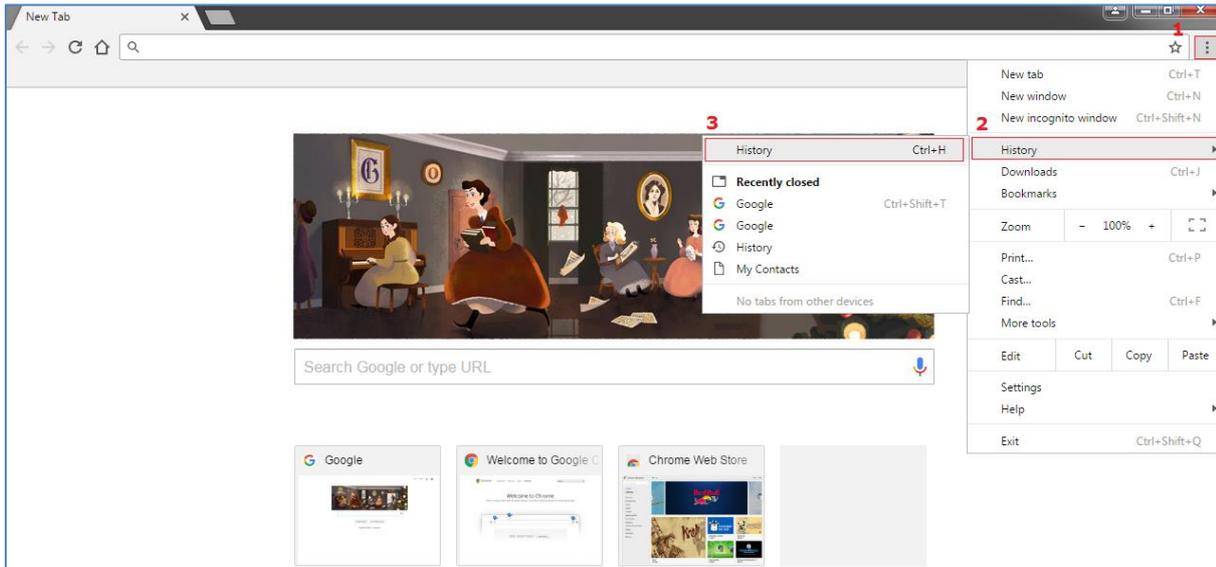


5. Then click the "Apply" button (Step 7), the "Delete" button (Step 8)

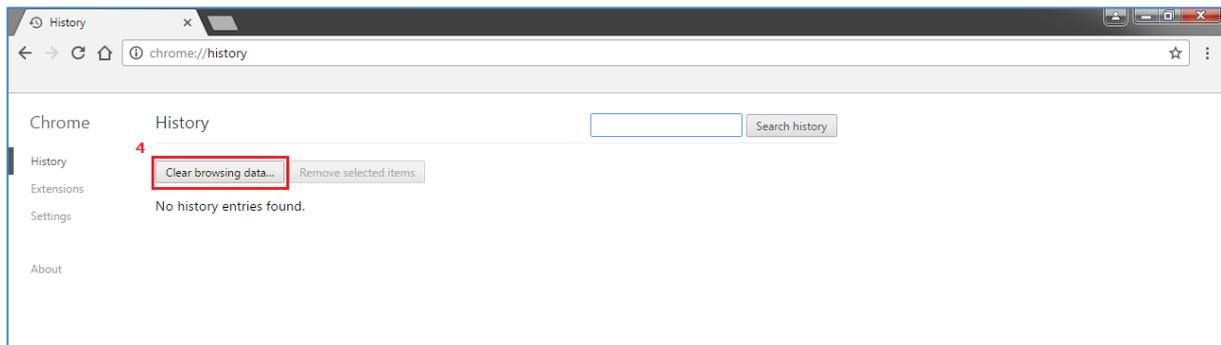


Clear cache in Google Chrome

1. In the upper right corner, press the button 
2. From the menu, select the "History" option.



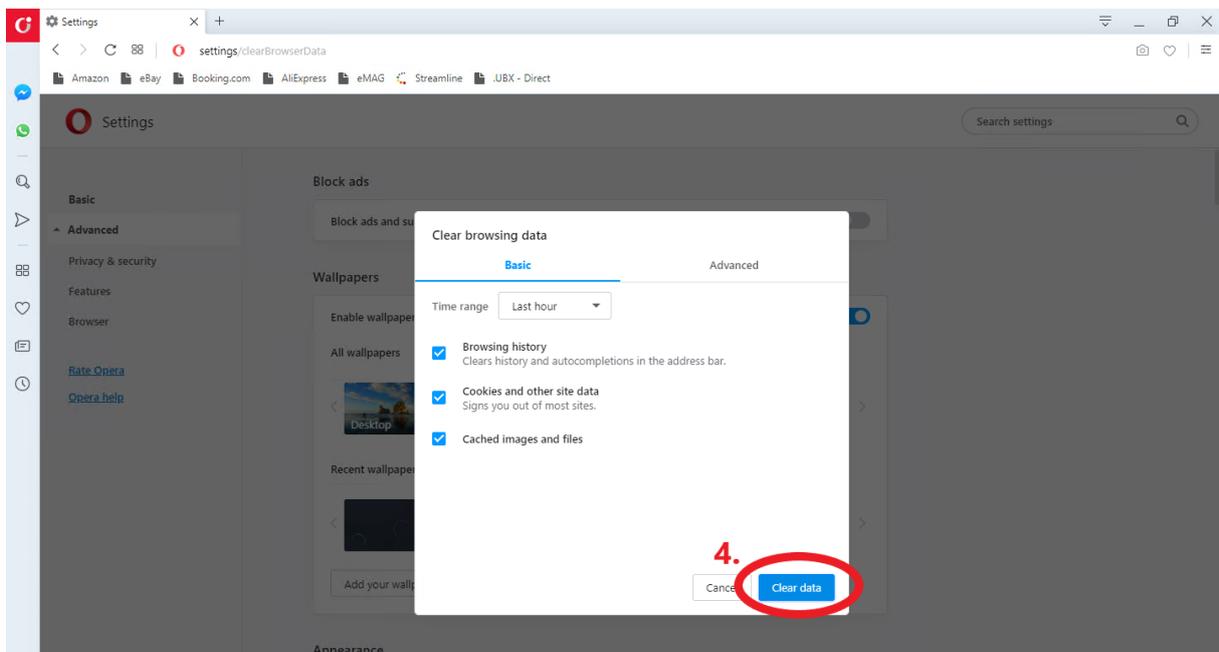
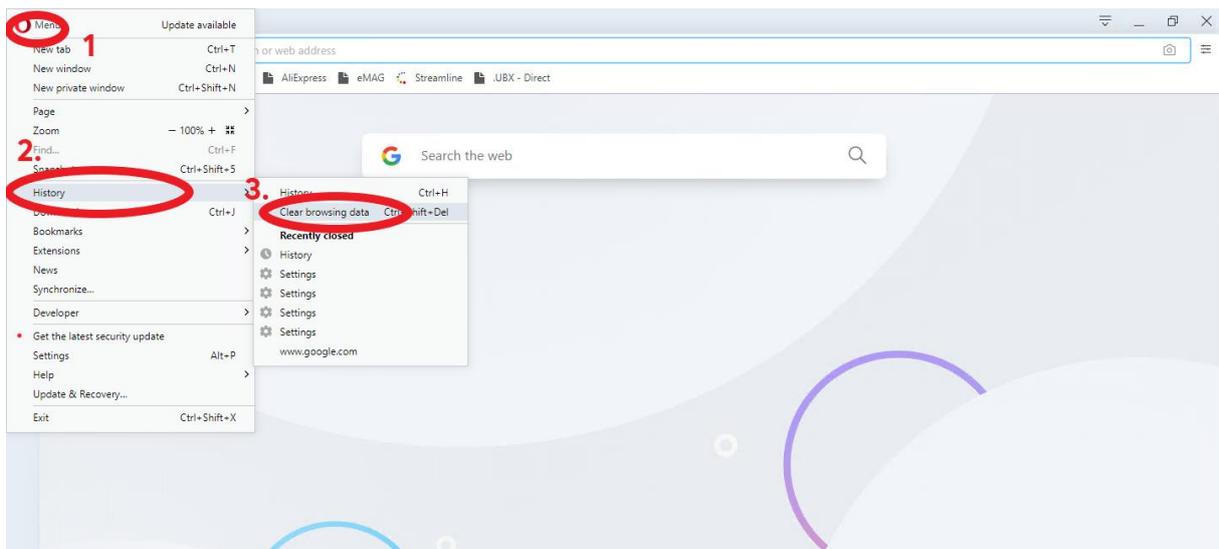
3. In the new menu, select "History" again.
4. Click the "Clear browsing data" button



5. In the pop-up window, select "the beginning of time"
6. Then select only the field "Cached images and files"
7. Complete the clearing by clicking the "Clear browsing data" button

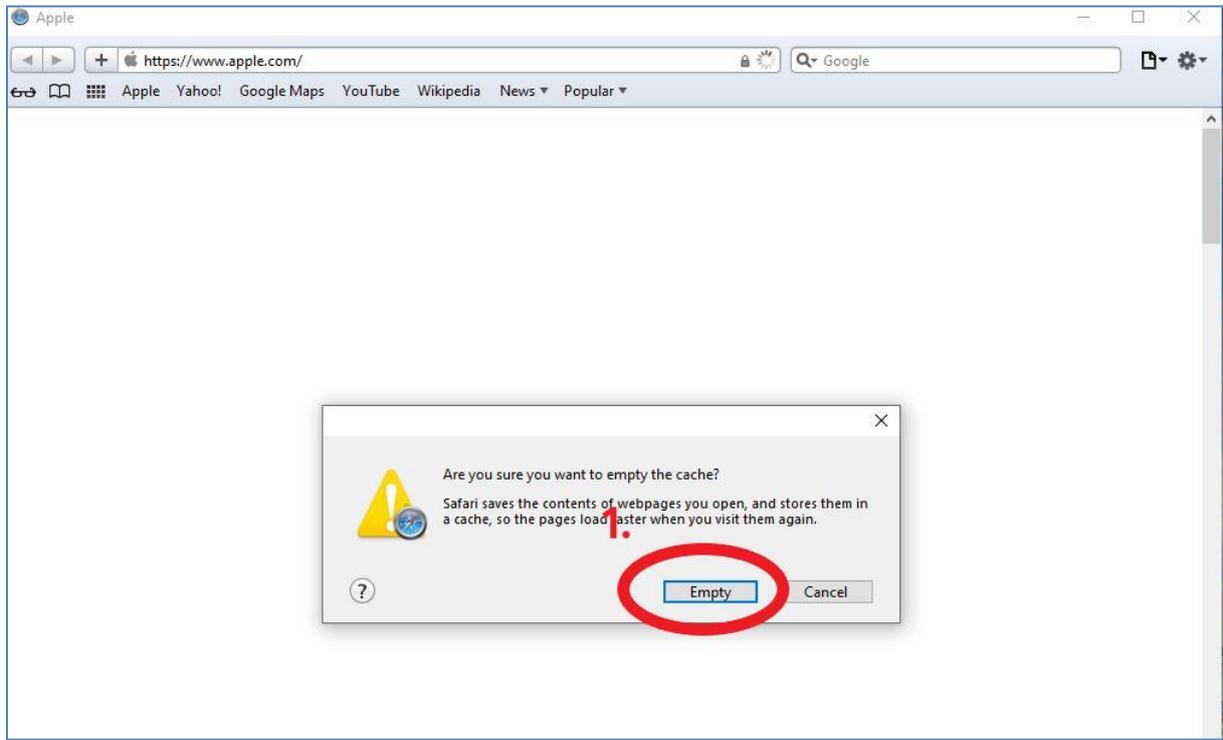
Clear cache in Opera

1. Open the "Settings" menu
2. Go to History
3. Go to "Clear browsing data"
4. In the window that will open, select "Clear data".



Clear cache in Safari

1. Press Ctrl + Alt + E. After that click the button "Empty" .



Clear cache in Microsoft Edge

1. Select "Settings and more"  > button Settings
2. Select "Privacy, search, and services."
3. Click the button "choose what to clear"
4. Select "Clear Now".
